Purpose

This award is presented annually by the Arkansas ACTE to recognize policymakers who have made a contribution of significance to Career and Technical Education in Arkansas.

Criteria and Eligibility

The award is presented to the individual or individuals who are determined to have made the most significant impact on policy related to career and technical education either during the past year or over an extended career of public service. (This award is not limited to one recipient for the Arkansas House of Representatives and one-recipient for the Arkansas Senate.) The award is open to individuals having decision-making authority as evidenced by public or legal sanctions.

Application Procedures

All nominations must come from Arkansas ACTE members Each nominee must be endorsed by an:

- Association
- Agency
- Group
- Or a combination of these

Groups nominating an individual for this award need to submit a cover letter stating the nominee's qualifications for the award and include supporting information listing significant legislative and other appropriate accomplishments related to career and technical education.

Deadline is February 1.
