Jean McEntire Outstanding Service Award



Purpose

To recognize an Arkansas educator who have made the highest meritorious contributions to the improvement, promotion, development, and progress of career and technical education

Criteria

The award will be presented to an individual who has made contributions or achieved prominence above salaried position assignments at the local and state levels. Nominees who have received recognition outside of their field of work and those who have made contributions of state significance will be most highly rated. Nominees must be active members, retired members, or retired former members of the Association for Career and Technical Educators (ACTE).

Eligibility

This award is given to an individual who is currently in the field of education or who has spent a significant part of his/her professional life in the field of education. The individual who has received special honors or recognition as a teacher, counselor, or administrator, who has held key local and state professional offices or committee appointments.

Application Procedures

- All nominations must come from Arkansas ACTE members.
- Each nominee must be endorsed by an:
 - Association
 - o Agency
 - o Group
 - \circ or a combination of these

Evaluation Criteria

The nominee will be evaluated on the following

 - \circ 0-10 years 5 points
 - \circ 11-20 years 10 points
 - 21-30 years 15 points 20 points
 - \circ 31+ years
- Professional Membership in CTE
- Community Involvement
- Presentations
 - State Level 5 Points
 - Regional Level 10 Points
 - National Level 20 Points
 - Significant Contributions to the field of CTE
